### **General Instructions**

- 1. The candidates are requested to reach the test venue at the scheduled reporting time indicated as above and in the Admit Card, beyond which they will not be allowed to enter the test venue. Any request for a change of date/venue will not be entertained.
- 2. The candidates are requested to report to the test venue at least half an hour before the commencement of the examination for identity verification.
- 3. The candidate will have to produce his/her Admit Card along with <u>original photo</u> <u>identity proof</u> at the test centre, which may be Aadhar Card, Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or PAN Card etc. along with its photocopy duly self-attested. Entry will not be allowed without original photo identity proof and Admit Card.
- 4. The candidates must carry a BLUE/BLACK ballpoint pen.
- 5. Issuance of the admit card or attending the written test shall not confer any right for an appointment or constitute any employment with CSIR-CSIO.
- 6. The candidature is subject to fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria as mentioned in Advertisement No. 02/2019.
- 7. The candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/costly items to the test venue as safekeeping of the same cannot be assured. The Organisation will not be responsible for any loss in this regard.

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- 8. Possession of electronic devices like mobile phones (even in switch off mode) etc. is strictly prohibited in the examination premises and it will be treated as use of unfair means
- 9. In case of non-compliance/use of unfair means, the candidature shall be cancelled and the candidate shall be debarred from appearing in future exams. Suitable legal action may also be initiated.
- 10. The candidates should follow COVID appropriate behaviour. They should maintain social distance and wear masks properly all the time at the venue of the examination.
- 11. The candidates, however, will have to remove their masks for verification, whenever required by the authorities/functionaries at the test venue.
